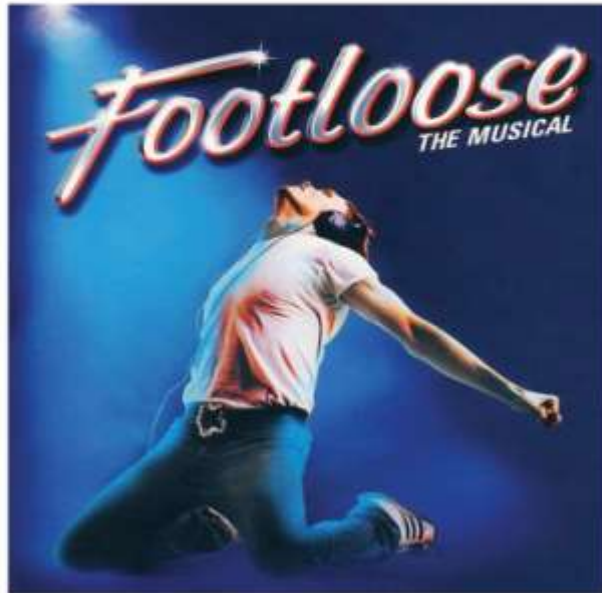

Principal Youth Cast (15-20yr olds):

(all require significant singing, dance and dialogue)

- Ren - a young rebel, dealing with pain by sarcasm and dancing.
- Ariel - not your typical preacher's daughter. Energetic and strong willed.
- Rusty - a bit of a ditz but knows everything about everybody.
- Willard - a simple country bumpkin with a warm heart.

Supporting Youth Cast (15-20yr olds):

(all require some singing and dance. Named parts have dialogue)

- Chuck - Ariel's boyfriend; a motorcycle riding, foul mouthed, leather wearing, trailer park product.
- Urleen & Wendy-Jo - Ariel's friends.
- Lyle & Travis - Chuck's friends.
- Jeter, Bickle & Garvin - Willard's country friends.
- Cowboy Bob - singer at the BBQ nitespot.
- Dance & singing high school chorus.

Principal Adult Cast:

(all significant singing and dialogue)

Please note the playing age of the adult cast are parents of teenagers.

- Reverend Shaw Moore - Ariel's father. The most powerful figure in Beaumont. Stern, Strict with a booming voice but also with a tender side
- Vi Moore - The strong willed preacher's wife, who feels like she is losing all her family.
- Ethel McCormack - Ren's mother. Strong willed single mother, who would do anything for her son.
